## Board To Weigh New Trial Regs

The IHDA Board will review a proposed set of new trial regulations at its General Meeting March 4 near Alden, IA. The meeting will be hosted by Wayne Bamber and Deb Meier.

The proposed new regulations consist mainly of a series of general rules about how trials are to be conducted, with an emphasis on safety of dogs and stock, and some basic rules of conduct for trial sponsors and participants (See the full text of the new trial rules on Page 2).

The new regulations—if approved as written—would also include a new five percent trial payback from sponsors to IHDA. Beginning in the 2007 season, it is proposed that IHDA trial and clinic sponsors pay back 5% of their gross receipts to IHDA. It is the second in a series of moves designed to halt a steady loss in IHDA funds over the past few years.

The board will also consider the establishment of a reimbursement fund to help defray any costs of injuries to stock or dogs participating in IHDA co-sponsored trials. The fund would be paid for through a \$1 fee paid by trial sponsors for each dog/entry at an IHDA trial or clinic. Sponsors may—if they wish—pass this cost directly on to participants.

Any payout from the fund would have to be proposed and seconded by a board member, and then passed by a majority of the board.

The balance in the fund is to be separately tracked and reported by the IHDA Treasurer. As soon as it reaches the \$2000 level, the \$1 fee will be discontinued until payouts from the fund become necessary. The IHDA Board may also elect to increase the amount in the fund in response to higher stock prices or veterinary costs.

## Proposed New Trial Regulations

### IHDA Reimbursement Fund

The IHDA Treasurer shall maintain a portion of the Association funds for the purpose of reimbursing trial directors, stock owners, and other IHDA members for losses at an IHDA sponsored event or clinic that are not otherwise covered through IHDA's insurance policy. The Reimbursement Fund is subject to the following regulations:

1. Trial and clinic directors shall contribute to the Reimbursement Fund \$1.00 for each *entry* (a dog entered twice counts as *two* entries) at all trials and clinics. Trial/Clinic directors may, at their discretion, add this charge to their entry fees.
  2. Payouts from the Reimbursement Fund must be proposed and seconded by the IHDA Board of Directors, and approved by a majority vote of the board.
  3. The amount of money in the Reimbursement Fund shall not exceed \$2000. This amount may be increased by a majority vote of the board.
- Once the amount of money in the Reimbursement Fund meets the limit approved by the IHDA Board, contributions to the fund outlined in (1) shall be discontinued until the amount falls below the limit.

### Payback to IHDA

Each IHDA sponsored trial will pay back 5 percent of gross income to the IHDA Treasury. For each *entry* in an IHDA

sponsored trial or clinic, Trial/Clinic directors shall contribute \$1.00 to the special IHDA Reimbursement Fund.

### General Regulations

1. Trial directors may act as a representative of the IHDA when questions of common courtesy and protocol arise.
2. A competitor who needs to have the course explained must ask questions before his/her run starts. After the run has started, explanations are entirely at the discretion of the trial judge.
3. A dog shall not compete in an IHDA event if it is sick or injured, unless approved by the judge and course director.
4. A handler being disqualified or retired must immediately cease working his/her dog.
5. Any handler retiring or leaving the trial course during a run will forfeit all points for that run, unless previously announced.
6. Training devices are not allowed on the trial course. Such devices include—but are not limited to—electric shock collars, prong collars, choke chains, leashes or ropes that are not detachable before the run, and any other devices designed to cause pain to or distract the dog while working.
7. A dog may not compete with two different handlers at the same event unless previously announced.
8. Trial coordinators and/or course directors may take appropriate actions should unsafe circumstances develop involving a dog, a handler, livestock, or spectators.

### Record Keeping

The trial secretary may not give out information about any individual's run until the score is posted, and the judge has reviewed the score sheets. By the end of the trial, all scores are to be either to be publicly posted, announced, or made available for all to see.

### Trial Conduct

1. A competitor shall not intimidate, attempt to intimidate, or argue with a judge, course director, trial coordinator or time keeper.
2. No competitor or person shall use any form of misconduct or harassment toward the trial management, judges, or IHDA officials.
3. Abusive language is not permitted on the trial course.
4. No instruction or distractions will be tolerated during competitive runs.
